I. OPENING OF MEETING 11:00 A.M.— at 160 N. LaSalle Street, Room S-401, Chicago, IL

II. PRESENT

At the outset of the meeting, Member Cronin nominated Member Cunningham to chair the meeting. Member Lowry seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

1. **Case No. S-CA-19-034

2. **Case No. S-CA-17-053

**3. Case No. S-CA-16-024
Jeannie Wells and Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County (Juvenile Probation Department)**

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Gudino moved to grant variance to accept the charging party's appeal. Member Lowry seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote. Member Gudino then moved to accept the Executive Director dismissal. Member Lowry seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.
