**Minutes of the State Panel Meeting
Held on June 11, 2019**

I. OPENING OF MEETING 11:00 A.M.— at 160 N. LaSalle Street, Room S-401, Chicago, IL

II. PRESENT

William Lowry, Chairman of the Board; John Cronin, Member of the Board; Kendra Cunningham, Member of the Board; Jose Gudino, Member of the Board; Thomas Willis, member of the Board; Helen Kim, General Counsel; Kimberly Stevens, Executive Director; Anna Hamburg-Gal, Associate General Counsel; and staff members. Chairman Lowry welcomed Thomas Willis the newly appointed state panel member.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD June 11, 2019

Chairman Lowry called for approval of the minutes of the June 11, 2019 meeting. Member Gudino moved to approve the minutes. Member Cronin seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

V. REVIEW OF PROPOSED WRITTEN DECISIONS AND ORDERS

1. **Case No. S-CA-16-024
Jeannie Wells and Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County (Juvenile Probation Department)**

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Willis made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Gudino seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

2. **Case No. S-CA-16-132
Service Employees Int'l Union Healthcare Illinois & Indiana and State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services**

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Gudino made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Cronin seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

VI. BOARD ACTIONS

1. **Case No. S-CA-18-160
Int'l Assoc. of Fire Fighters, Local 50 and City of Peoria**

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Cunningham moved to accept the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. Member Gudino seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

**2. Case No. S-CA-18-114
Policemen's Benevolent Labor Committee and County of Bureau and Sheriff of Bureau
County**

General Counsel Kim called the case, noted that Administrative Law Judge Donald W. Anderson issued a Recommended Decision and Order with no exceptions filed and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.
