III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD June 11, 2019

1. **Case No. S-RC-18-003
American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31 and Chief Judge
of the Circuit Court of Cook County**

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Gudino moved to hold this case until the August meeting. Member Willis seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

2. **Case No. S-CA-17-138
Champaign Firefighters, Local 1260 and City of Champaign (Fire Department)**

General Counsel Kim called the case, noted that Administrative Law Judge Matthew S. Nagy issued a Recommended Decision and Order with no exceptions filed and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

3. **Case No. S-CB-18-036
Vincent Clemens and Wauconda Professional Firefighters, Int'l Association of Fire Fighters,
Local 4876**

Member Willis recused himself from this case. General Counsel Kim then called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Gudino moved to accept the Executive Director dismissal. Member Cunningham seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

4. Case No. S-SI-20-001
