**1. Case No. S-RC-19-018

Metropolitan Alliance of Police, Bolingbrook Chapter #3 and Village of Bolingbrook (Police Department)**

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Cunningham moved to reject and remand the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. Member Gudino seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

**3. Case No. S-CA-18-007  
Laborers' Int'l Union of North America, Local 773 and Alexander County Housing Authority**

Member Cunningham rescued herself from this case. General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Gudino moved to accept the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order.
