1. Case No. S-CA-17-115  
**American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31 and State of Illinois, Central Management Services (Department of Human Services)**

2. Case No. S-CA-19-109  
**Laborers, Local 1084 and City of Nokomis**

General Counsel Kim called the case, noted that Administrative Law Judge Matthew S. Nagy issued a Recommended Decision and Order with no exceptions filed and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

3. **Case No. S-CA-19-057**  
**Metropolitan Alliance of Police, DuPage County Forest Preserve, Chapter 714 and Forest Preserve District of DuPage County**

General Counsel Kim called the case, noted that Administrative Law Judge Anna Hamburg-Gal issued a Recommended Decision and Order with no exceptions filed and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

4. **Case No. S-CA-20-018**  
**Sharon Gladney and State of Illinois, Central Management Services (Commerce & Economic Opportunity)**

General Counsel Kim called the case and presented the case to the Board. After discussion, as to the first part of the case, regarding granting variance to allow the appeal, Member Gudino made a motion to grant the variance for the appeal. Member Cunningham seconded the motion, the motion passed with four ayes and one nay; Member Willis dissented. As to the second part of the case, Member Gudino made a motion to accept the Executive Director Dismissal. Member Cronin seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.
