**Minutes of the State Panel Meeting
Held on September 10, 2019**

I. OPENING OF MEETING 11:00 A.M.— via video conference: 160 N. LaSalle Street, Room S-401, Chicago, IL and 801 S. 7th Street, Suite 1200A, Springfield, IL

II. PRESENT

William Lowry, Chairman of the Board; John Cronin, Member of the Board; Jose Gudino, Member of the Board; Thomas Willis, Member of the Board; Helen Kim, General Counsel; Anna Hamburg-Gal, Associate General Counsel; and staff members participated via video conference from the Chicago location. Kendra Cunningham, Member of the Board; Kimberly Stevens, Executive Director; and staff members participated via video conference from the Springfield location.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD August 13, 2019

Chairman Lowry called for approval of the minutes of the August 13, 2019 meeting. Member Gudino moved to approve the minutes. Member Cronin seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

IV. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Chairman Lowry asked Executive Director Stevens to present the reports. She presented the reports and summarized their highlights.

V. REVIEW OF PROPOSED WRITTEN DECISIONS AND ORDERS

- A. Case No. S-RC-18-003
**American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31 and Chief
Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County****

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Gudino made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Willis seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

- B. Case No. S-CA-19-065
**Bonnie K. Miller-Herron and State of Illinois, Department of Central Management
Services (Financial and Professional Regulation)****

General Counsel Kim called the case. Member Willis made a motion to approve the proposed written decision. Member Gudino seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

VI. BOARD ACTIONS

- 1. Case No. S-CA-18-108
North Riverside Fire Fighters, Local 2714 and Village of North Riverside**

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Willis moved to accept the administrative law judge's recommendation decision and order and reinstate the firefighter. Member Gudino seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

2. **Case No. S-CA-18-158**
Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council and City of Oak Brook Terrace

General Counsel Kim called the case, noted that Administrative Law Judge Sharon Purcell issued a Recommended Decision and Order with no exceptions filed and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

3. **Case No. S-CB-19-016**
Thomas Tate and Carmelita Terry and Illinois Municipal Police Association #1

General Counsel Kim called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Gudino moved to accept the Executive Director's dismissal and deny the motion for sanctions. Member Willis seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

4. **Case No. S-RC-19-060**
Policemen's Benevolent and Protective Assoc. Labor Committee and County of Marion and County Clerk, Treasurer, Supervisor of Assessments, Coroner and Sheriff of Marion County and Laborers Int'l Union of North America

Member Cunningham recused herself from this case. General Counsel Kim then called and presented the issues of the case to the Board. After discussion, Member Willis moved to reject the Executive Director's direction of representation election and remand for hearing. Member Gudino seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

VII. EXECUTIVE SESSION

After a short discussion regarding whether there was a need for executive session, the Board concluded it was unnecessary.

No members of the public sought to make comments.
