Lt. Gov. to speak on water safety, public service in Chicago on Thursday

CHICAGO – Lt. Governor Evelyn Sanguinetti will deliver remarks at two public events on Thursday, June 28, to raise awareness about water safety, and to encourage young people to become involved in public service.

Lt. Governor Sanguinetti will first address attendees at Valentine Boys & Girls Club, where more than 200 children are being recognized for completing the Zac Foundation's water safety camp. The ZAC Foundation was established by Karen and Brian Cohn after the loss of their 6-year-old son, Zachary Archer Cohn, who became trapped in a drain in their backyard swimming pool. The Foundation's advocacy and education efforts have reached thousands of children and their families directly, with millions more reached through social media and news outlets.
