

ILLINOIS HEALTH CARE FRAUD ELIMINATION TASK FORCE

**Public Meeting
June 26, 2019
2:00 P.M. - 3:30 P.M.**

The Health Care Fraud Elimination Task Force met and held a meeting open to the public on June 26, 2019, at 2:00 p.m. at the JRTC, 100 W. Randolph, Suite 16-504, Chicago, Illinois 60601. There was a live videoconference feed to the State Capitol located at 207 State House, 2nd Floor, Room 205V, Springfield, Illinois 62706. Individuals also participated via conference call.

The Task Force member in attendance was the Executive Inspector General for the Office of Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor. There were also representatives from the following agencies - Department of Insurance, Office Department of Healthcare and Family Services, Department on Aging, Office of Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor, Department of Human Services, and Department of Central Management Services.

I. Chair's Welcome

Executive Inspector General (EIG) Susan Haling, Chair of the Task Force, welcomed the Task Force members. Members of the Task Force introduced themselves.

The minutes from the March 25, 2019, public meeting had previously been circulated to the Task Force via email. The Task Force members adopted the minutes. Chair EIG Haling made a motion that because this was the last public Task Force meeting, that the minutes from this June 26, 2019, meeting be adopted via email. The motion was adopted.

II. Bills Impacting Task Force Agencies

Representatives from the Department of Insurance, Department of Central Management Services, and the Department of Healthcare and Family Services discussed recent bills that have passed both houses or have been signed into law, and how those bills or laws impact the Medicaid, State Employee Group Insurance, or Workers' Compensation working groups and agency members of the working groups.

III. Message From The Chair

Chair EIG Haling thanked everyone for their contributions to the Task Force. Chair EIG Haling recapped some of the Task Force's accomplishments over the past three and a half years. Chair EIG Haling said that although the Task Force would not be continuing, she encouraged agencies to communicate with one another about shared issues and opportunities. Deputy Inspector General – Executive Projects Christine Benavente also thanked the Task Force for its hard work and participation. DIG – Executive Projects Benavente stated that during a telephone conference that occurred earlier this month with Task Force member agencies, the member agencies asked to continue to hold standing calls for the three working groups every other month to come together to discuss issues that cross agency lines and brainstorm opportunities to address those issues collectively. DIG – Executive Projects Benavente also said that members requested a document with Task Force participants contact information on it to better facilitate

communication. DIG – Executive Projects Benavente said she would circulate information about the conference calls and the contact list via email.
