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2020 School and Campus Security Training Program



This program is funded through state Homeland Security Grants. Training is provided to public and non-public schools, higher education institutions, law enforcement, first responders, local emergency management agencies, and critical infrastructure officials.



The program provides awareness and preparedness level training to enhance organizational capacity to plan for, respond to, and recover from an emergency or disaster.

All courses are provided free of charge and many qualify for Illinois Administrator Academy credit, continuing education units or professional development units.

Traditional classroom courses, workshops, webinars and online training modules are among the methods of training offered.
