**NOTICE TO MUNICIPALITIES IN COOK COUNTY REGARDING THE
RECENTLY ENACTED MUNICIPAL MOTOR FUEL TAX**

Public Act 101-32, signed into law by Governor Pritzker on June 28, 2019, authorizes municipalities in Cook County to impose a tax on motor fuel at a rate of up to 3¢ per gallon, with the tax to be administered by the Illinois Department of Revenue.

This new local tax requires the Department to develop new forms, make programming changes, and provide guidance to affected taxpayers. The Department is working to implement these changes and will provide additional details soon for municipalities in Cook County who are interested in imposing this tax.
