INFORMATION BULLETIN FY83-13

TO: All Licensed Fuel Blenders

SUBJECT: Schedule "M"

The Department has completed an evaluation of Schedule "M" (Blending Detail) and has determined that a redesign is necessary to extract complete information within uniform guidelines. A copy of the revised schedule is enclosed.

Following are headings listed on the revised Schedule "M" with an explanation of what the Department considers acceptable.

COLUMN #1 The actual date that blending took place. Do not
DATE BLENDED: list invoice date, date of receipt, etc.

COLUMN #2 Primary product is the largest volume (gallon
PRIMARY PRODUCT amount) used in the blending process. No other
GALLONS: product gallons are to be listed.

A-GASOLINE/B-DIESEL

Enter gallons of primary product under correct heading. Only gallonage figures should be listed for these specific products.

C-OTHER

If you used any primary product other than gasoline or diesel is used, you must list the complete name of the product immediately above the GALLONAGE figure.

COLUMN #3 You are to list the gallons of agents being blended
BLENDING AGENT(S) with the primary product.
GALLONS:

A-ALCOHOL

Enter gallons of alcohol used to blend with primary product. Only alcohol gallons are to be listed.

B\C-OTHER

any agent other than alcohol must be listed using the complete name of the product immediately above the GALLONAGE figure.

COLUMN #4
TOTAL END
PRODUCT SALES:

List the end product gallonage under the correct heading.

A-GASOHOL

If the end product of blending is gasohol, list the TOTAL GALLON amount.

B-DIESELHOL

If the end product of blending is dieselhol, list the TOTAL GALLON amount.

C-OTHER

If the end product is something other than gasohol or dieselhol, list the complete name of the product immediately above the TOTAL GALLONAGE figure.
