RE: Elimination of Schedule B

The State of Illinois supports the goal - of the National Governors' Association and others - of achieving uniformity among the states in the administration of interstate motor fuel use taxes (MFUT). As a step toward this goal, the Illinois Department of Revenue will no longer require MFUT taxpayers to file Schedule B (list of Illinois fuel purchases) with their quarterly tax returns (Form IDR-280).

The elimination of Schedule B is effective beginning with third-quarter 1987 returns (due on or before October 31, 1987).
