TO: ALL ORGANIZATIONS +---+ HOLDING OR APPLYING FOR LICENSES TO CONDUCT CHARITABLE GAMES	If your organization has requested a license to hold some events before September 1, and some events after September 1, the Department will approve only those events scheduled on or before September 1.	If legislation allows us to issue licenses again for charitable games, you will be notified so that you may apply for a license for your events.

QUESTIONS?

After September 1,
1988, charitable games
events may no longer be
conducted in Illinois.
This is because the
Charitable Games Act
(Section 8 (14)) states
that "no license for
the conducting of
charitable games shall
be issued or effective
after September 1,
1988."

Your application and
fee will be returned if
you submit an
application for a new
or renewed license to
conduct charitable
games events, all of
which are scheduled for
a date after
September 1.

The Department will
continue to accept and
process applications
and issue licenses to
organizations which
schedule events through
September 1.

Future Legislation
Possible
Legislation could be
enacted that would
allow the Department to
once again issue
charitable games
licenses. The
legislature will be
reconvening in late
November, and
consideration of
charitable games
legislation is possible
at that time.
