TO: Retailers in +---+Madison County	(Jarvis, Ft. Russell, and Moro) have been annexed into the mass transit district, and, therefore, retailers in those townships must pay the tax effective July 1. They will join retailers from the following townships who have been paying the tax since February of 1981: Alton, Chouteau, Collinsville, Edwardsville, Godfrey, Granite City, Nameoki, Venice, Wood River.	How to Report the County Supplementary Tax and the Mass Transit Tax You should report your county supplementary tax on line 50 of your RR-1-A (sales tax return) and your transit tax on lines 46-49 of the RR-1-A. There are two separate
 tax changes effective
 July 1, 1988 in Madison
 County. One is a 1/4
 percent county
 supplementary tax
 imposed throughout the
 county. The other is
 the Metro-East Mass
 Transit District tax
 that now affects the
 townships of Jarvis,
 Fort Russell, and Moro.

Countywide Increase in Sales Tax

The countywide increase
 of 1/4 percent is for
 the county
 supplementary tax.
 Revenues from this tax
 go to the county
 government. (For more
 information on this
 tax, refer to Bulletin
 88-19.)

Metro-East Mass Transit District Expanded

The transit tax rate of
 1/4 percent remains the
 same. However, three
 new townships

How to Know if You're Now Included in the Mass Transit District

The map on the back of
 this bulletin shows the
 boundaries of the
 Metro-East Transit
 District. If you are
 located anywhere within
 the boundaries of the
 transit district, you
 must collect the
 transit tax.

Retailers in the
 village of Bethalto
 should take note:
 With the annexation of
 Ft. Russell Township,
 retailers in the entire
 village of Bethalto are
 in the mass transit
 district and subject to
 the tax.
