|TO:|Retailers in St. Clair County
The township of Smithton has been annexed to the St. Clair County Transit District. Therefore, effective December 1, 1988, retailers in that township must collect the 1/4 percent sales tax* imposed by the mass transit district. They will join retailers from the following townships who are already

paying the tax:
Belleville, Canteen, Caseyville, Centreville, East St. Louis, Lebanon, Mascoutah, O'Fallon, St. Clair, Stites, Stookey, Shiloh Valley, and Sugar Loaf.
How to Report the Mass Transit Tax
You should report your mass transit tax on lines 46-49 of the RR-1-A.
