

+ ILLINOIS ELECTRONIC FILING PILOT PROJECT

We are conducting a pilot project for tax year 1990 allowing taxpayers to file their Illinois individual income tax returns electronically.

The program will apply only to taxpayers who are expecting a refund or have no balance due on their 1990 individual income tax returns. The program will not allow the direct deposit of refunds by electronic means.

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 HOW DO I FILE?

You must use the services of any preparer or transmitter who has been accepted in both the IRS and Illinois programs.

WHAT FORMS MAY I FILE ELECTRONICALLY?

You may, through your preparer or transmitter, file the following firms:

- IL-1040, Illinois Individual Income Tax Return

- Schedule NR, Non-resident and Part-Year of Illinois Tax
- Form 2210, Computation of Penalty for Underpayment of Estimated Tax by Individuals
- Form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement
- Form W-2G, Statement of Certain Gambling Winnings
- Form W-2P, Statement for Recipients of Annuities, Pensions, Retired Pay or IRA Payments

If your return includes forms and schedules not listed above, you cannot file your return electronically.

WHEN MAY I FILE ELECTRONICALLY?

You may file between February 1, 1991, and April 15, 1991.

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WHO MAY APPLY?

If you have been approved in the IRS electronic filing program, you may apply.

If you apply as a transmitter, you must have at least one year of experience transmitting in the IRS program.

HOW DO I APPLY?

You must submit Form IL-8633, Illinois Electronic Filer Application to File Individual Income Tax Returns Electronically. We will conduct "suitability checks" to determine your eligibility.

WHAT IS THE DUE DATE FOR APPLICATION?

We must receive your application by January 21, 1991.

HOW DO I GET THE FORMS I NEED?
