+ CHANGES TO REPLACEMENT VEHICLE TAX FORMS

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<p> TO: INSURANCE +---+COMPANIES</p> <p>We have recently combined Form RVT-1, Replacement Vehicle Tax Return, and Form RVT-7, Replacement Vehicle Certificate, into one return, Form RVT-7, Replacement Vehicle Tax Return.</p>	<p>"Passenger car" is defined in Section 1-157 of the Illinois Vehicle Code as "a motor vehicle of the First Division, including a multipurpose passenger vehicle, that is designed for carrying not more than 10 persons."</p>	<p>QUESTIONS</p> <p>If you have questions or need more information, please call or write us. 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WHEN MUST I FILE THE NEW RETURN?

We will soon send you a supply of the new Form RVT-7. Beginning April 1, 1991, you must file this return and destroy all of your old Replacement Vehicle Tax forms. After this date, we will no longer process the obsolete returns.

As the insurance company, you are required to provide ALL information required on the form.

NOTE: We can accept returns only for vehicles that are classified as passenger cars and are purchased in Illinois.

TO WHOM SHALL I SEND THE COMPLETED FORM RVT-7?

UNDER WHAT CIRCUMSTANCES MUST I FILE A REPLACEMENT VEHICLE TAX RETURN?

You must file the new Form RVT-7 when replacing the passenger car of an insured person in the settlement of a total loss claim that DOES NOT involve a cash settlement.

When you start using the new return, be sure to send us Page 1 along with your payment. Send Page 2 to the dealer. Keep Page 3 for your records.
