

■ Change in the Motor Fuel Use Tax Rate

TO: All Licensed Interstate Motor Carriers

Effective January 1, 1995, the "Part B" rate of the Motor Fuel Use Tax was established for diesel fuel, gasoline, gasohol, liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), and compressed natural gas (CNG).

What is the "Part B" rate?

The "Part B" rate is equal to 6.25 percent of the average selling price per gallon of motor fuel sold in Illinois. This average is an official figure that is computed annually.

What are Illinois' 1995 "Part B" motor fuel rates?

The "Part B" rates for 1995 are as follows:

Diesel	6¢
Gasoline	5.5¢
Gasohol	5.5¢
LPG	5.4¢
CNG	4.8¢

How do I figure my combined Motor Fuel Use Tax rate?

The combined tax rates are as follows:

	"Part A"	"Part B"	Combined
Diesel	21.5¢	6¢	27.5¢
Gasoline	19¢	5.5¢	24.5¢
Gasohol	19¢	5.5¢	24.5¢
LPG	19¢	5.4¢	24.4¢
CNG	19¢	4.8¢	23.8¢

The combined rate is preprinted

- in Column I of the IFTA fuel summary in Form MFUT-15, IFTA Motor Fuel Use Tax Quarterly Return, and
- on Line 8 of Form MFUT-16, Illinois Interstate Motor Fuel Use Tax Quarterly Return.
