



■ Changes in Motor Fuel Bonding

TO: Illinois Distributors, Receivers, Suppliers, or Bulk Users of Motor Fuel

Effective January 1, 1998, the maximum bond amount increases for any person licensed as a distributor, receiver, supplier, or bulk user of motor fuel from \$40,001 to \$100,000.

What is the purpose of motor fuel bonds?

Motor fuel bonds serve to ensure that Illinois distributors, receivers, suppliers, or bulk users meet their tax obligations on motor fuel sold, distributed, and used.

Who must furnish a bond, and how is a bond provided?

All persons acting as distributors, receivers, suppliers, or bulk users of motor fuel are required to furnish a bond prior to licensing and may be required to provide a larger bond amount after licensing.

Applicants for a license as a distributor, receiver, supplier, or bulk user of motor fuel in Illinois must apply with the Illinois Department of Revenue. Before being issued a license, the applicant must file a bond with the department.
