Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax Rate Changes Effective January 1, 2012

This bulletin is written to inform you of recent changes; it does not replace statutes, rules and regulations, or court decisions.

Effective **January 1, 2012** the municipalities listed below and on the next page are either imposing a simplified municipal telecommunications tax or increasing their simplified municipal telecommunications tax rate. The combined rates are the statewide rate of 7.00 percent (.07) **plus** the Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax imposed at the local level (up to a maximum rate of 6.00 percent outside Chicago).
