4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 46

5 changing Section 143.28 as follows: 47

6 (215 ILCS 5/143.28) (from Ch. 73, par. 755.28) 50

7 Sec. 143.28. The rates and premium charges for all 52

8 policies of automobile insurance, as described in sub-section 53

9 (a) of Section 143.13 of this Code, shall include appropriate 54

10 reductions for insured automobiles which are equipped with 55

11 anti-theft mechanisms or devices approved by the Director. 56

12 To implement the provisions of this Section, the Director 58

13 shall promulgate rules and regulations. ~~The rules and~~

14 ~~regulations promulgated hereunder shall include procedures~~ 59

15 ~~for certification to insurers that anti-theft mechanisms and~~ 60

16 ~~devices have been installed properly in insured vehicles.~~ 61
