



Supplemental Mitigation Guidance for Home Visiting, Doula, and Coordinated Intake Programs

This is a supplement to the Restore Illinois Guidance for Home Visiting, Doula, and Coordinated Intake Programs issued on August 31, 2020 by the Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program (MIECHV), the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS), the Illinois Head Start Association (IHSA), and the City of Chicago Department of Family and Support Services (DFSS). The provisions in that guidance continue to stand.

If your community goes into any tier of mitigation, consult with your County or Local Health Department about whether to reconsider the brief 15-minute in-person contacts and go back to virtual-only activities. Throughout all phases of restoration and mitigation, services must be provided in accordance with IDPH and CDC guidelines (including face coverings and social distancing).

This guidance is subject to change in response to developments during the pandemic, and in alignment with any future updates to the Restore Illinois plan.
