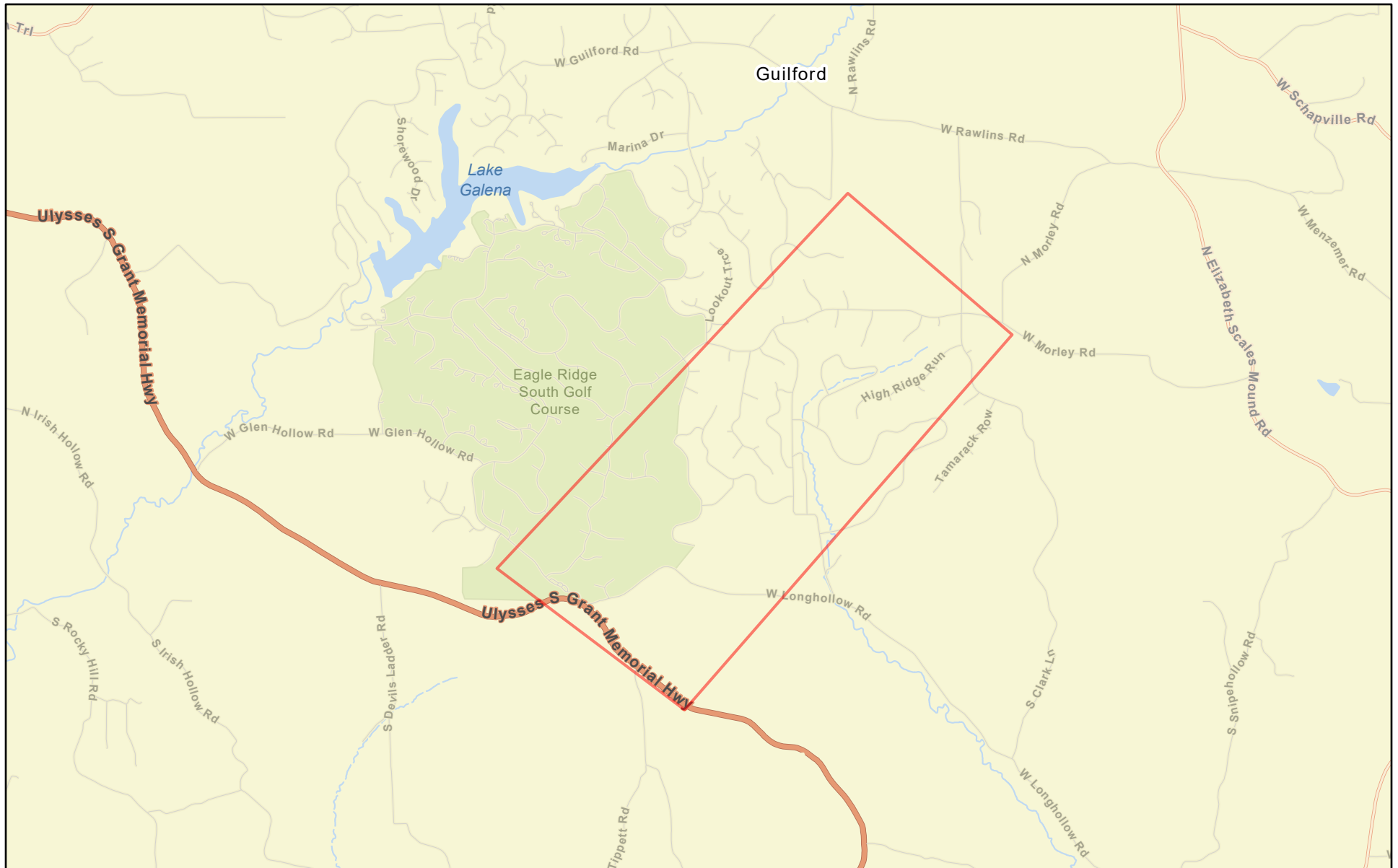


2020 Gypsy Moth MD Treatments JoDavie County 2,694 acres (IL_JoDavie_1)

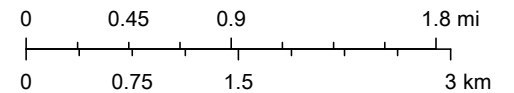

The area above, outlined in red, is to be treated for an infestation of the European Gypsy Moth with Mating Disruption (MD). The product to be used is called SPLAT GM Organic, and it is made from water, wax and vegetable oil with pheromones. This pheromone is the sexual attractant for male gypsy moths. The droplets of SPLAT GM confuse the male moths in an area so they can not find real female moths. The area will be treated late June, weather permitting, by low flying yellow 'Air Tractors' also known as Crop Duster airplanes.
