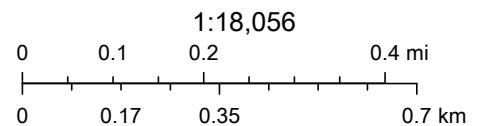


2020 Gypsy Moth Btk Treatments Ogle County 122 acres (IL_Ogle_1)

This area to be treated for an infestation of the European Gypsy Moth with Btk -*Bacillus thuringiensis* var. *Kurstaki*. Btk is a bacterial insecticide that occurs naturally, it is cultured by fermenting grains. Foray 48B Organic is the product used. The area will be treated mid May, weather permitting, with retreatment 7-10 days later. The Btk will be sprayed from low flying helicopters.
