This area to be treated for an infestation of European Gypsy Moths with Btk, *Bacillus thuringiensis* var. *kurstaki*. Btk is a bacterial insecticide that occurs naturally, it is cultured by fermenting grains.

The area will be treated mid May, weather permitting, with retreatment 7-10 days later. The Btk will be sprayed from low flying helicopters
