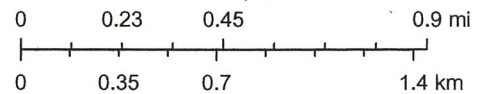


# 2019 Gypsy Moth Btk Treatments Will County Joliet 1,467 acres

This area to be treated for an infestation of European Gypsy Moths with Btk *Bacillus thuringiensis* var. *kurstaki*. Btk is a bacterial insecticide that occurs naturally, it is cultured by fermenting grains.

The area will be treated mid May, weather permitting with retreatment 7-10 days later. The Btk will be sprayed from low flying helicopters
