Spreading the Word on Risk Management



DoIT's Division of Information Security recently provided training to the Springfield Chapter of the Institute of Internal Auditors on their Risk Management program and the current risk assessment process. The group of 70 auditors learned how data is classified, systems are categorized and how risk is assessed, both at the system level and the organizational level. This information will give auditors a better understanding about how security controls can fit into their procedures.
