Seventeen agencies, boards and commissions have accomplished migrations to Illinois.gov with five other agencies nearing completion and three more in progress. This centralization of IT services results in cost efficiencies, improved data security and audit compliance management. The data center continues to improve customer services by implementing hybrid cloud technologies that include virtualization, elastic data storage and upgraded tools to manage the health, availability and performance of information technology resources. The first solar eclipse over the U.S. since 1979 reached its point of greatest duration on Aug 21st, just a few miles south of Carbondale, IL. Southern Illinois University (SIU) along with NASA Eclipse 2017, the Adler Planetarium of Chicago and the Louisiana Space Consortium hosted a variety of celestial events at SIU Saluki Stadium to celebrate this rare astronomical event.
