DoIT is in the process of deploying Office 365 to desktops across the enterprise. Register now for the [Help Me kNow Hub™](#) for self-guided learning tools to support our familiar family of desktop productivity applications, including: Outlook, Word, PowerPoint and Excel to name a few. First time registrants will need to provide basic information and create a password and enter the **registration code "Illinois"**. Please take advantage of this limited opportunity through the month of June to participate in a unique educational experience. Also through June 30<sup>th</sup>, an Office 365 specialist is available via the DoIT Help Desk at 217.524.3648 or 312.814.3648 option 1 for IT, then option 5 for Office 365 one-on-one assistance with anything from how to set an out of office notification to creating pivot tables in Excel.

AT&T is decommissioning their Web Connect service effective June 30, 2018. If you have not been converted to VoIP service and need to continue using AT&T Audio Conferencing, you may do so. Agencies that have been converted to VoIP service are encouraged to transition to WebEx, a part of the Collaboration Suite of services that does not carry additional usage costs. WebEx has become a frequently used tool to augment video conference and face-to-face meeting options.
