### DOI's Financial Regulator Dashboard

The Department of Insurance (DOI) continues to modernize core solutions and the quarterly review process for insurers was the most recent to benefit. The Financial Corporate Regulatory Division now has a more effective way to track, manage and maintain their analysis work. Staff has already realized the overall benefits of a more efficient review process, enhanced communication and less duplicative reporting. This multi-phase solution is poised to next provide benefits to the actuarial review process by adding alerts and notifications to ensure more timely reviews. The system enhancements have integrated information stored in disparate systems, providing a better mechanism for review. Dashboards are being created to provide analysts, supervisors and DOI leadership with critical information at a glance which will improve the entire team's responsiveness and awareness.

### DoIT's Personal Information Management (PIM) Offerings

DoIT continues to deploy **Office 365** with the most recent conversion at the Illinois Council on Developmental Disabilities and Healthcare and Family Services next on the docket. Several smaller boards, commissions, and councils are soon to follow. **Microsoft Teams**, currently being piloted in small groups, integrates with the Office 365 productivity suite and combines chat, meetings, notes and attachments. The deployment team also continues to assess best ways to promote the use of the **OneDrive for Business** feature – a great way to store, synch and share files in the cloud.
