Revenue Continues to Offer Shared Apps

The **Legislative Tracking System (LTS)** facilitates the routing of bills for review and allows users of the system to provide comments directly in the application. Each user is provided a dashboard to keep track of bills with pending deadlines. If you have any interest in the system, please email LTS.Support@illinois.gov. If legislation is not your area of interest, maybe vehicle inventory management is more your speed. The manual processes of the **Automotive Cost Reporting System (ACRS)** have been replaced by automated service reminders, scheduling requests, receipt, work order and upload capability. If interested, send requests to FMS.Support@illinois.gov. Another shared system is the **Telecom Invoice Approval (TIA) System**, which provides telecom invoices digitally with approvals performed electronically. There is opportunity to reduce paper, while providing an audit trail. For a demo or to inquire about implementation, please email TIA.Support@illinois.gov.
