
Dear Mr. Galassie:

On November 9, 2009 Plainfield Surgery Center provided your office a letter in response to a request that the surgery center received asking for comments related to the proposed project's impact on Plainfield Surgery Center (PSC). That letter was not intended to be viewed as a letter of opposition to the project, but simply as a response to the request.

That letter was written prior to the filing of DMG's application. Having reviewed DMG's application, Plainfield Surgery Center is now of the opinion that the proposed DMG project will have minimal, if any impact on Plainfield Surgery Center because the pain management specialists who will be referring patients to the DMG facility are not currently performing procedures at PSC.

Understanding that the proposed ASTC will provide interventional pain management services exclusively, Plainfield Surgery Center does not oppose the approval of the above referenced project, as long as the proposed facility operates as a single specialty facility, providing **only** interventional pain management services, and is not allowed to expand into a multi-specialty facility. We would strongly oppose the expansion of services beyond interventional pain management.
