Dear Mike:

Thanks for asking us to clarify our Impact Statements for each of the above CON applications, #10-023 - #10-025. DaVita's CON applications to acquire the University of Chicago's three (3) dialysis facilities clearly state the intent to add stations to each facility (see Pages 70 of each CON application.)

Please note that in order to expand both the Woodlawn and Lake Park facilities we will need to relocate these facilities since their leases expire in the near future (see documentation in Attachments 75(3) of each of the CON applications.) These facilities will be relocated to sites within a mile or two of their current sites to continue serving their existing communities. DaVita's current plans are to add up to 12 stations each to the Woodlawn and Lake Park facilities, increasing stations from 20 to 32 stations each.

As you know, the Stony Island facility was recently completely modernized, and DaVita will continue to operate the facility at its current site. However, DaVita will need to further evaluate whether there is sufficient room at the site to expand service. There will surely be no decrease in stations.

The intent of all three acquisitions is to increase the availability of stations and access to care for patients living in these communities.
