

I am recently aware of an application for a certificate of need from Proctor Hospital in Peoria regarding an inpatient Medical Psychiatric unit. This would be a new service in our community and a benefit to the elderly patients who need acute mental health inpatient care. It would be a unique service in that it would also be able to treat the medical and somatic co-morbidities that often exist in this population.

I have often referred patients to the outpatient counseling and have been impressed with their care. I frequently see hospitalized patients that would be more appropriate for a unit such as that proposed.

As a practicing family physician for 19 years in this community, I have seen a significant decrease in the inpatient services available for psychiatric care while simultaneously seen an increase in the number of elderly and nursing home patients requiring such care. 
