As the **State Representative** for that district, I am delighted to write this letter of support for the approval of **St. Joseph's Hospital's Certificate of Need application** to permit the development of the new St. Joseph's Hospital.

For more than 134 years, St. Joseph's Hospital has provided the residents of Highland and the surrounding communities with high quality in-patient and outpatient care.
