

Fresenius treats any patient regardless of ability to pay, and the clinics that have been established throughout the State have been located in both affluent and economically challenged areas within the state. In rural county Illinois, for example, Fresenius established a clinic in Bolingbrook approximately ten (10) years ago that started with fifteen (15) stations which has now been expanded to twenty-four (24) stations. 


