Mercy Circle is a continuum of care retirement community located on the boundary of the City of Chicago and the Village of Evergreen Park. The address is 10000 S. Central Park Avenue, Chicago.

It received a permit for 24 skilled nursing beds in 2011 (Project Number 11-008). In 2012, the permit was altered reducing the number of beds to 23. The facility opened in 2014.

As a condition to the permit, admission to skilled nursing was limited to residents of the continuum care retirement community and members of religious orders.

This application seeks to remove the restrictions on the skilled nursing beds.

There is no project cost.

This is a substantive project because it is considered an expansion of an existing Long Term Care service.






The applicant shall provide:

2. A certified listing of any adverse action taken against any facility owned and/or operated by the applicant during the three years prior to the filing of the application.
3. Authorization permitting HFSRB and DPH access to any documents necessary to verify the information submitted, including, but not limited to: official records of DPH or other State agencies; the licensing or certification records of other states, when applicable; and the records of nationally recognized accreditation organizations. **Failure to provide such authorization shall constitute an abandonment or withdrawal of the application without any further action by HFSRB.**
4.  - The percentage of project referrals used to justify the proposed expansion cannot exceed the historical percentage of applicant market share, within a 24-month period after project completion
 - Each referral letter shall contain the referral source's Chief Executive Officer's notarized signature, the typed or printed name of the referral source, and the referral source's address
4. Provide verification by the referral sources that the prospective resident referrals have not been used to support another pending or approved Certificate of Need (CON) application for the subject services.
5. **If a projected demand for service is based upon rapid population growth in the applicant facility's existing market area** (as experienced annually within the latest 24-month period), the projected service demand shall be determined as follows:
 - a. The applicant shall define the facility's market area based upon historical resident/patient origin data by zip code or census tract;
 - b. Population projections shall be produced, using, as a base, the population census or estimate for the most recent year, for county, incorporated place, township or community area, by the U.S. Bureau of the Census or IDPH;
 - c. Projections shall be for a maximum period of 10 years from the date the application is submitted;
 - d. Historical data used to calculate projections shall be for a number of years no less

than the number of years projected;

- e. Projections shall contain documentation of population changes in terms of births, deaths and net migration for a period of time equal to or in excess of the projection horizon;
- f. Projections shall be for total population and specified age groups for the applicant's market area, as defined by HFSRB, for each category of service in the application (see the HFSRB Inventory); and
- g. Documentation on projection methodology, data sources, assumptions and special adjustments shall be submitted to HFSRB.

 - a. An average annual occupancy rate that has equaled or exceeded occupancy standards for general LTC, as specified in Section 1125.210(c), for each of the latest two years.
 - b. If prospective residents have been referred to other facilities in order to receive the subject services, the applicant shall provide documentation of the referrals, including completed applications that could not be accepted due to lack of the subject service and documentation from referral sources, with identification of those patients by initials and date.
2. Projected Referrals
The applicant shall provide documentation as described in Section 1125.540(d).
3. **If a projected demand for service is based upon rapid population growth in the applicant facility's existing market area** (as experienced annually within the latest 24-month period), the projected service demand shall be determined as described in Section 1125.540 (e).

Criterion 1125.560 - Variances to Computed Bed Need

Continuum of Care:

The applicant proposing a continuum of care project shall demonstrate the following:

1. The project will provide a continuum of care for a geriatric population that includes independent living and/or congregate housing (such as unlicensed apartments, high rises for the elderly and retirement villages) and related health and social services. The housing complex shall be on the same site as the health facility component of the project.
2. The proposal shall be for the purposes of and serve only the residents of the housing complex

and shall be developed either after the housing complex has been established or as a part of a total housing construction program, provided that the entire complex is one inseparable project, that there is a documented demand for the housing, and that the licensed beds will not be built first, but will be built concurrently with or after the residential units.

3. The applicant shall demonstrate that:
 - a. The proposed number of beds is needed. Documentation shall consist of a list of available patients/residents needing the proposed project. The proposed number of beds shall not exceed one licensed LTC bed for every five apartments or independent living units;
 - b. There is a provision in the facility's written operational policies assuring that a resident of the retirement community who is transferred to the LTC facility will not lose his/her apartment unit or be transferred to another LTC facility solely because of the resident's altered financial status or medical indigency; and
 - c. Admissions to the LTC unit will be limited to current residents of the independent living units and/or congregate housing.

Defined Population:

The applicant proposing a project for a defined population shall provide the following:

1. The applicant shall document that the proposed project will serve a defined population group of a religious, fraternal or ethnic nature from throughout the entire health service area or from a larger geographic service area (GSA) proposed to be served and that includes, at a minimum, the entire health service area in which the facility is or will be physically located.
2. The applicant shall document each of the following:
 - a. A description of the proposed religious, fraternal or ethnic group proposed to be served;
 - b. The boundaries of the GSA;
 - c. The number of individuals in the defined population who live within the proposed GSA, including the source of the figures;
 - d. That the proposed services do not exist in the GSA where the facility is or will be located;
 - e. That the services cannot be instituted at existing facilities within the GSA in sufficient numbers to accommodate the group's needs. The applicant shall specify each proposed service that is not available in the GSA's existing facilities and the basis for determining why that service could not be provided.
 - f. That at least 85% of the residents of the facility will be members of the defined population group. Documentation shall consist of a written admission policy insuring that the requirements of this subsection (b)(2)(F) will be met.
 - g. That the proposed project is either directly owned or sponsored by, or affiliated with, the religious, fraternal or ethnic group that has been defined as the population to be served by the project. The applicant shall provide legally binding documents that prove ownership, sponsorship or affiliation.





PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT

1. Document that the project will provide health services that improve the health care or well-being of the market area population to be served.

This application seeks to remove restrictions on the admission to Mercy Circle's skilled nursing facility.

Mercy Circle is a faith-based, not for profit continuing care retirement community. It was approved by the Board in 2011. Mercy Circle is the only CCRC in the immediate area that does not have an admission fee.

It was designed to serve as a replacement for the Mercy Convent located on the same campus. It was expected that approximately 70% of the initial Mercy Circle residents would be from the Sisters of Mercy and that many of the remaining residents would come from other religious orders in the area.

At the time it was estimated that the Sisters of Mercy was spending in excess of \$3 million per year for the cost of care and services for its members and for maintaining other facilities in the Chicago area. Having them live at Mercy Circle would maintain the cost while providing a high quality of care and services.

Planning for the project began about 10 years ago. In 2008 the Chicago City Council approved zoning required for the CCRC. The Village of Evergreen Park sued claiming that the site of the CCRC was restricted to use for educational purposes.

Mercy Circle was originally scheduled to open in 2012. Construction was substantially delayed due to litigation by the neighboring suburb of Evergreen Park. After significant litigation a settlement was reached reducing the size of the project.

Pursuant to the Settlement Mercy Circle filed an Alteration in 2012 reducing the number of residential units, reducing the number of skilled nursing beds by one and reducing the cost of the CCRC by approximately \$5 million dollars. The Settlement also provided restrictions on entrance to the CCRC and the skilled nursing facility.

At the time the application was filed there were approximately 803 Sisters of Mercy members. Of those members 195 lived in the Chicago area. Over 85% were over 65 years of age. Currently it is estimated that only 85 sisters remain in the Chicagoland area. The demand for the CCRC from the members of religious orders is declining over time putting a strain on Mercy Circle's finances. In addition due to the State's budget woes, Mercy Circle is owed \$1 million by the State. Removing restrictions on admission to the SNF expands access to health care of the market area population. It will help Mercy Circle continue to provide a high quality faith based facility for any patient who chooses to live there.

2. Define the planning area or market area, or other, per the applicant's definition.

Mercy Circle is in Planning Area 6-C. The market area was defined by a study included in the original application. The list of zip codes in the primary and secondary market areas follows this Attachment.

3. Identify the existing problems or issues that need to be addressed, as applicable and appropriate for the project.

The problem that needs to be addressed is the restrictions on admission to the skilled nursing facility. That is discussed in more detail above.

4. Cite the sources of information provided as documentation.

Mercy Circle maintains a log of inquiries from hospitals seeking to place patients in skilled nursing beds. There were nearly 200 inquiries in 2016. The log is included in Attachment 13.

5. Detail how the project will address or improve the previously referenced issues, as well as the population's health status and well-being.

The project will open access to Mercy Circle's SNF to everyone in the area. The need for additional beds in a faith based setting is demonstrated by the hospital referral log included in Attachment 13.

6. Provide goals with quantified and measurable objectives, with specific timeframes that relate to achieving the stated goals as appropriate.

If this project is approved Mercy Circle will immediately make its skilled nursing beds available to the general public. That will improve access to care in a faith based setting in the area.



ARKET AREA

The market area was determined based on geographic and demographic considerations, and GSI's professional experience, including the use of "industry rules of thumb" in the absence of primary market (survey) data.

The market area is contained within an approximate seven to ten mile radius around the project site. It is further divided into primary (PMA) and secondary (SMA) market areas.

- The PMA stretches approximately three to five miles from the project site and includes the following zip code areas 60415, 60453, 60456, 60459, 60620, 60643, 60652, 60655 (Project zip code), 60803.
- The SMA surrounds the PMA and extends beyond its boundaries for an additional four to five miles. It includes the following zip codes 60805, 60406, 60426, 60428, 60445, 60452, 60455, 60457, 60458, 60462, 60463, 60464, 60465, 60469, 60472, 60480, 60482, 60501, 60609, 60619, 60621, 60628, 60629, 60632, 60636, 60637, 60638, 60827.

ALTERNATIVES

A. Proposing a project of greater or lesser scope and cost;

This is a no cost project. Applicant is seeking to remove the CCRC and defined population restrictions on admission to its existing skilled nursing beds. A project of lesser scope would not save any money. It would not meet the demand for the existing beds by area residents as demonstrated by nearly 200 hospital referral inquiries in 2016. A project of lesser scope was rejected.

A project with additional beds was also rejected. The skilled nursing portion of the original project cost approximately \$270,000 per bed. Using that cost as a guide a 10 bed addition would cost \$2.7 million dollars. Applicant does not have available capital funds to support an increase in beds. The alternative of a greater scope and cost was rejected.

B. Pursuing a joint venture or similar arrangement with one or more providers or entities to meet all or a portion of the project's intended purposes; developing alternative settings to meet all or a portion of the project's intended purposes;

The project involves the removal of restrictions on access for the skilled nursing portion of a CCRC. The CCRC is a faith based community. It provides on-site access to chaplain services, priests and worship opportunities.

The SNF already exists. There would be no savings by entering into a joint venture with other providers.

Alternative settings to meet all or a portion of the project's intended purposes is not applicable.

C. Utilizing other health care resources that are available to serve all or a portion of the population proposed to be served by the project;

Applicant is a faith based facility. It does not have an entrance fee for admittance to its CCRC. It is the only faith based rental CCRC in the area. Other area nursing homes do not provide the service to this particular faith based facility.

D. Provide the reasons why the chosen alternative was selected.

Applicant chose the alternative of seeking removal of restrictions on entrance to the SNF. There is no cost. It will immediately make the beds available to area residents

providing additional income to support its faith based services provided to persons in the CCRC.

Over the long term the defined population now eligible to enter the SNF is expected to decline. Removing the restrictions will better position Applicant to keep the facility full and allow it to maintain a high quality services to its resident.

1. The excess beds in Planning Area 6-C was 410 as of the 2015 Inventory.
2. Applicant attests that the primary purpose of the project is to serve residents of the planning area and that at least 50% of the patients will come from the planning area.

Mercy Circle's staff kept a log of requests for placements from Hospitals. That log follows this page.

There were 195 requests in 2016. The number of admissions in 2016 was only 31. Mercy Circle was limited to accepting patients only from the CCRC and patients that met the religious restrictions under the defined population variance.

The names and addresses of existing LTC facilities within a 30 minute travel time from Mercy Circle is also included.

2. The project will not result in a maldistribution of services.

Mercy Circle is approved for only 23 beds. Most of those beds are occupied. The opening of Mercy Circle's beds to the general public will have an insignificant impact on other providers.

3. The project will not lower utilization of other providers.

Mercy Circle is located in Planning Area 6-C. It is adjacent to Planning Area 7-E. There are over 13,000 beds in those areas. Mercy Circle has only 23 beds or less than two tenths of one percent (.002) of the beds in those areas. There is no significant impact to other providers now or within 24 months after project completion.
