As State Senator for the 30th District, I am writing in support of US HealthVest's Certificate of Need to expand and enhance behavioral health services on the Vista Medical Center West campus. There is a serious unmet need for specialized psychiatric services that has resulted in patients being deferred or denied treatment in ever increasing numbers. Approval of this application will begin to increase access to these key services in Waukegan, North Chicago, throughout Lake County and beyond. According to the latest Lake County Community Health Assessment Report, mental health issues affect 23% of adults in Lake County with suicide being the 10th leading cause of death in Lake County. The Report also indicated that mental health was the highest priority when identifying and building system capacity. I am critically aware of the lack of inpatient psychiatric services. Lake County struggles to find the appropriate care for its residents with chronic and acute mental health issues. My constituents end up in programs or facilities where distance adversely impacts family participation in treatment and aftercare services.
