Dear Members of the Review Board:

I am writing in support of the Certificate of Need for Davita Oak Meadows Dialysis.

Kidney disease is often undetectable by the patient until the late stages when it is often too late to stop or slow the disease. Significantly, poverty is a key driver of health status, and as a result, many low-income patients who lack health insurance do not have access to nephrologist care until they are diagnosed and in the later stages of chronic kidney disease when kidney failure is imminent. At that point, dialysis becomes life-sustaining.

Within the proposed patient service area for Oak Meadows – a significant portion of which is a portion of my legislative district – 13.6% of residents live at or below the federal poverty limit for Illinois and 23.2% live at or below 150% of the federal poverty level, which is the cut-off used for Medicaid eligibility. To further magnify this issue, 9.6% of residents of the patient service area are uninsured. To help counteract this dynamic, I am pleased to know that Davita is a non-discriminatory provider, who accepts and dialyzes patients, despite their ability to pay.
