Dear Mr. Constantino,

In a letter dated June 14, 2017 SwedishAmerican Hospital requested to add ten neonatal beds to its facility. This addition resulted in a total of 209 Medical Surgical beds, 30 ICU beds, 32 AMI beds, 34 OB beds, 28 pediatric beds, and 10 neonatal beds. SwedishAmerican Hospital now has a total of 343 beds.

The IDPH Division of Health Care Facilities and Programs, Central Office Section determined that this change in beds meets the licensing requirements and is effective September 10, 2019.

These additional ten neonatal beds became operational on May 16, 2019.

Dear Dr. Born:

In a letter dated June 14, 2017 you requested to increase your number of Neonatal beds by 10. This results in a total of 209 Medical Surgical beds, and 30 ICU beds, 32 AMI beds, 34 OB beds, 28 ped beds, 10 Neo beds, with a total bed count of 343 beds at Swedish American Hospital, Rockford. The Health Facilities Services and Review Board approved this request in the bed complement without a permit per the State Board rule 77 Ill. Adm. Code 1130.140, which allows a health care facility to change its bed complement without a permit.

The IDPH Division of Health Care Facilities and Programs, Central Office Section has determined that this change meets the licensing requirements and is effective September 10, 2019.

You are required to notify the IDPH when these beds become operational. Please forward a letter to the Illinois Department of Public Health, Division of Health Systems Development, Program Review Section, 525 West Jefferson St, 2nd Floor, Springfield, IL 62761-0001, to the attention of Mike Constantino with the effective date the additional beds became operational.

The Inventory of Health Care Facilities Services and Need Determination will be adjusted following receipt of the notification that the beds are operational.
