RE: Establishment or Expansion of a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit Health Facilities Planning Act--Part 1130 Exemption.

Dear Ms. Campbell:

On July 14, 2020, the Chairman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board) acting on behalf of the State Board under 77 IAC 1130.531 approved your request for the expansion of the 10-bed neonatal intensive care unit at SwedishAmerican Hospital, 1401 East State Street, Rockford, Illinois. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of 77 IAC 1130.531. The cost of the project is \$221,545 and expected completion date is June 30, 2022. The exemption involves the conversion of 14 Level II Beds to 14 Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Beds for a total of 24 Level III Intensive Care Beds. According to our records the Hospital has the following number of beds:

You are reminded that a final cost report must be submitted to the State Board no later than 90 days following the anticipated project completion date. You are also reminded that failure to complete the project within the 24 months after the Board approved the exemption will invalidate the exemption. Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable to this transaction.
