
RE: Discontinuation of 32 Hospital Licensed Acute Mental Illness Beds

This letter is to provide notice under the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act that on September 17, 2019, the Health Facilities and Services Review Board approved the exemption application of HSHS St. John's Hospital to discontinue its acute mental illness category of service.
