On October 13, 2020, the Chairman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board) acting on behalf of the State Board under 77 ILAC 1130 (Part 1130) approved your request for the discontinuation of the 18-bed long term care category of service at Swedish Covenant Health d/b/a Swedish Hospital, 5145 N. California Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of Part 1130. As the result of this discontinuation the categories of service and the number of beds at the Hospital are as follows:
