On November 13, 2020, the Chairman of the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board (State Board) acting on behalf of the State Board under Part 77 IAC 1130 approved your request for a discontinuation of obstetric services at Holy Cross Hospital, 2701 West 68th Street, Chicago, Illinois. The approval was based upon the application's compliance with applicable provisions of 77 IAC 1130. As result of this discontinuation of a category of service the Hospital has the following categories of service and beds:

You are reminded that the issuance of the certificate of exemption is contingent upon the submittal of a statement to the State Board within 90 days of the closing date of the transaction that certifies the discontinuation has been completed in accordance with the key terms contained in the application. To demonstrate completion of this transaction, the exemption holder must provide the State Board with the date that the discontinuation occurred. Failure to provide the required notification shall subject the exemption holder to the sanctions provided under Section 14 of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act.

The State Board's approval does not exempt the transaction from any other regulatory, certification or licensure requirements that may be applicable.
