
Dear Ms. Avery:

This is to inform you that the change of ownership transaction(s) which were approved per the above-referenced exemption applications, took place on 03/1/17. The change of ownership was in accord with the material terms as described in the exemption applications.

When the exemption applications were submitted outstanding permits were noted for all applicable facilities. In addition, since the applications were filed, Rush Oak Park Hospital received a permit on 01/24/17 to replace its emergency department (project 16-043). We understood that per the Illinois Health Facilities & Services Review Board rules, all CON permitted projects must be obligated prior to the change of ownership occurring, and as a result we made sure this was the case. I am therefore confirming that all outstanding permits held by Rush University Medical Center (directly or as a co-applicant), Rush Oak Park Hospital and Rush Copley Medical Center are obligated at this time.
