Matt Hartman has worked in the long term care profession for eight years in a number of roles. He began at the Illinois Health Care Association in late 2004 as a legislative liaison. In 2007 the Health Care Council of Illinois was formed to represent the public policy interests of both the Illinois Health Care Association and the Illinois Council on Long Term Care. At that time he transitioned to that group and served as the Legislative Director. In each of these roles he worked to forward the legislative, regulatory and political initiatives of the profession. This involved extensive research on various topics and close working relationships with regulators, legislators and other parties interested in long term care to understand the needs of the profession and forward sound policy.

In August of this year Matt transitioned back to the Illinois Health Care Association staff to serve in a membership and development role. In this position, he worked closely with providers to assure they have an understanding of the legislative and regulatory environment they function in, and to help them to maintain compliance through one on one assistance and intervention. As well, this allowed him to continue working with members and regulators on development of regulatory initiatives and solutions.
