

Re: Illinois Power Agency Procurement Plan Regarding FutureGen

Dear Messrs. Barry, Buchovecky, and Champagne:


Pursuant to our meeting with you, Ameren, and ComEd on Monday, March 19, 2012, this letter describes the next steps that the Illinois Power Agency ("IPA") will take in its consideration of the sourcing agreement provided by FutureGen. As we have discussed in our meetings, the IPA has looked into the issue of contracts with Alternative Retail Electric Suppliers ("ARES") and its current understanding is that the Illinois Commerce Commission ("ICC" or "Commission") has the ability to compel the utilities and ARES to enter into sourcing agreements with a Retrofitted Clean Coal Facility ("Retrofitted CCF").

FutureGen has presented the IPA a draft proposed sourcing agreement, and the IPA intends to schedule a series of meetings with Ameren, ComEd, ARES, ICC Staff, and other interested stakeholders to solicit feedback on the terms of the proposed sourcing agreement, and discuss alternatives to the terms proposed by FutureGen. The IPA intends to include a discussion and consideration of Clean Coal resources in its next procurement plan. The objective of these meetings will be to determine whether the IPA will propose a clean coal procurement event as part of that plan, to be submitted to the Commission in September 2012.

While the IPA believes the subject plans to move forward are reasonable next steps, it reserves the right to modify or change them at any time.
