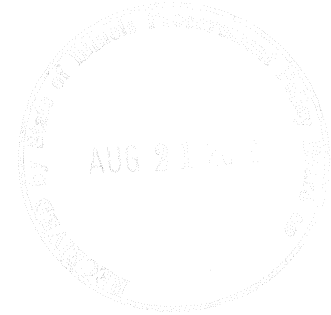



Thanks again for meeting with us last week. The Alliance anticipates that it will have a revised PPA submitted to the IPA by no later than Monday, July 16. I have reached out to both ComEd and Ameren Illinois today regarding the format of the load data required to calculate the clean coal rate adjustment and the mechanism for final settlement. Assuming they provide this information in a timely manner re-drafting the contract by the above date should not be a problem. I will keep you informed if we are running into any issues.
