Mr. Barry inquired about the approach the IPA was considering to take to respond to Commissioner McCabe's data requests in Docket No. 13-0034. Mr. Barry asked if the IPA would be providing a response that was consistent with previous statements the IPA had made relating to the release of benchmark information. Mr. Strong indicated that the IPA would be providing a response similar to that which the IPA had discussed previously. Mr. Barry indicated that the FutureGen Alliance would also likely provide a response similar to that which the IPA had provided previously. Mr. Strong advised that the IPA would not be opposed to having FutureGen provide a response similar to that which the IPA had provided previously. Mr. Strong also advised that the IPA would support granting the FutureGen Alliance an opportunity to review benchmark information before it was released to the public to ensure that confidential or proprietary information was not released. Mr. Barry thanked Mr. Strong for the IPA's support on the benchmark confidentiality issue.
