## **IPA Communication Detail**

### **Detailed Summary:**

- Invernergy called the IPA for clarification regarding the 2012 Rate Stability Winter Procurement RFP. Invernergy inquired about (1) which load forecast the ComEd REC Targets were based on and (2) whether the renewable budget for the procurement represented the entirety of the remaining budget or a portion thereof.
- Invernergy was informed that ComEd's "low" load forecast was used and that the budget for the procurement represented the remaining expected unutilized budget assuming the low load forecast.
- Invernergy and IPA also discussed increased load migration and the eventual need to amend the renewables rules in the state. Mention was made of RPS changes currently embedded in the "Tenaska Bill," which awaits a vote in the House.
- Invernergy did not lobby the IPA for any changes to the procurement or Illinois renewable policy.
